CONCERT TIME: 2:00-3:30 pm, Sunday, May 18, 2014

*ALL tickets will be picked up at Will Call before the concert. Some of the students will be in a rehearsal, so parents will have plenty of time to get their tickets.

*STUDENTS DO NOT NEED TICKETS! Students and their one family member will have passes to enter the concert hall. They will be in a reserved section of the audience or onstage for the entire concert. There will also be an area reserved for families of the youngest children so that they can sit with their parent(s).

*Sunday Rehearsal for Bach Double and up players will begin at 12:45. Please, please, please do not be late!! Please be tuned and on stage ready to begin the rehearsal!

*The concert begins at 2:00 and will last until approximately 3:30. Although this is not the same as our Rocktacular concert last year, it is not a typical play down.

*Concert attire is dressy, but not formal. Please no jeans or skirts above the knee.

*CAMERAS: PLEASE NO flash photography during the concert! DVDs will be available for purchase.

*The Raffle and Silent Auction will close and be drawn during a break in the concert. Items MUST be picked up afterwards in the lobby.

Directions:

From VA and points south:

1. Take I-95 North to Washington, D.C.'s Capital Beltway (I-495).
2. Take Exit 25B (U.S. 1 South / Baltimore Avenue toward College Park).
3. Exit 25B ends at a traffic light. Turn right onto Route 1 South.
4. Proceed approximately 1-2 miles South on U.S. Route 1 / Baltimore Avenue.

5. Exit right onto I-93 West (University Blvd.) towards Byrd Stadium.
 6. At the second traffic light, turn left onto Stadium Drive.
 7. Go 1/4 of the way around the traffic circle and go to the right (Valley Drive)
- From Baltimore and points north:
1. Take I-95 South to Washington, D.C.'s Capital Beltway (I-495).
 2. At the 495 split, be sure to go toward the right (495 West).
 3. Be in the left lane so you can immediately take Exit 27 toward Route 1 South, College Park.
 4. Follow signs to Exit 25 (U.S. 1 South toward College Park).
 5. Follow steps 4 through 7 above.

Parking:

Option 1: Free Parking on Lot 1

On Sundays, visitors may park for free in Lot 1, the large surface lot just beyond the Center.

OR

Option 2: Pay Stations at Stadium Drive Garage

You may pay for your parking space in increments of 15 minutes, hours or the whole day at one of the five pay stations or through an automated phone system. Sunday all day is only \$5.

Here's how it works: 1. Park in garage; 2. Take note of your space number, 3. Make payment

Pay Stations: There are 5 pay stations located at the pedestrian entrances/exits to the garage. You can pay with credit card or cash. Please use exact change because the pay stations do not provide change. There is a daily maximum of \$5 on Sundays.
